Revolutionary War Veteran Memorial

On Sunday May 28 at 2:30 p.m., the Christian Ardinger Chapter of the Sons of American Revolution will hold a memorial service for the Revolutionary War Patriot, Christian Ardinger, at his grave site in the Riverview Cemetery at Williamsport.

Christian Ardinger, a native of Pennsylvania, migrated to Washington County, after the close of the Revolutionary War, where he lived for the remainder of his life, and became one of the co-founders of the town across the Potomac River to Virginia, by the State of Maryland.

Other Revolutionary War patriots buried in Riverview Cemetery include General Otho Holland Williams, Colonel George Adam Woltz, and private John Nitzell. Among the many living descendants of Christian Ardinger is Ellen Ardinger Zeller (Mrs. Dennis T.), who is a member and officer of the local Conococheague Chapter of the Daughters of American Revolution.

John W. Hoffman, President of the local Chapter of SAR will preside at the ceremony. Other members participating will be Howard Spessard, Harold Lehman, and Jacob Hoffman. Living descendants, friends and all interested persons are invited to attend the ceremony.
